**OFFICE ORDER**

To achieve the objective of Ganga Rejuvenation the role of innovative technology is immensely relevant. It has been observed that a number of competing technologies are available both in India and outside for various aspects of Pollution Control and River Rejuvenation. Normally adoption of such technology should be based on proper assessment as well as pilot implementation where ever necessary.

2. Accordingly, it has been decided to constitute an expert committee with following composition:-

- (a) Prof. Vinod Tare, Convener, IIT Consortium on GRBMP
- (b) Director, NEERI
- (c) Member Secretary, Central Pollution Control Board: Convener

3. The committee will look into the specific technology related issues referred to by MoWR, RD&GR/ NMCG and make their recommendations considering following aspects.

- (a) Technical suitability of the proposed technology in Indian context especially Ganga River Basin.
- (b) Feasibility of introduction of this technology for Ganga Rejuvenation and the specific area in which the same can be used.
- (c) Details of competing technologies, if any.
- (d) Financial feasibility of the proposed technology
- (e) Limiting conditions if any.
- (f) Need for pilot implementation if required.
- (g) Recommendations for implementation.
- (h) Any other aspect considered necessary by the Committee.

4. The Committee will specifically look into available competing technology options, need for technology neutrality as also the life cycle cost while making recommendations.

5. The Committee may undertake visits to the sites where such technologies are already in operation and conduct such meetings as it deemed necessary.

6. The committee will submit report to NMCG within 60 days of receipt of references in this regard.

7. The Committee will remain in operation till further orders. The expenditure incurred on this account will be met by NMCG.
