1. The invitation for Bid follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in UNDB online on 30.03.2011 & updated last on 31.01.2014
2. The National Ganga River Basin Authority (NGRBA), Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation, Government of India has received financing of US\$ 1 billion from the World Bank towards the cost of the National Ganga River Basin Project and intends to apply a part of the proceeds towards payments under the contract for work detailed below.
3. The NMCG, State Governments of Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and West Bengal and the ULB have entered into a Memorandum of Agreement for implementation of the NGRBA programme in the respective states.
4. The State Government of Uttar Pradesh , Kanpur Municipal Corporation and Government of India have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding towards the implementation of this project forming a part of the NGRBA Programme.
5. Qualification requirements as listed briefly below are required to be fulfilled by the bidder. [Bidders are advised to refer to the bidding documents for complete details]

#### **Financial:**

- (a) Net worth of INR 750 **Million** or US\$ 12.0 **Million** in each of the last 3 financial years (i.e FY 2013-2014 , FY 2014-2015 & FY 2015-2016,).
- (b) Cash credit facility of INR 250 **Million** or US\$ **4.0Million**

#### **Technical:**

- (a) Experience of design, build & commissioning during last 7 years, of at least
  - (i) One project of construction / Laying of Sewerage Network of minimum 60 Km Length of which minimum 9 Km should be above 500 mm diameter pipes
  - (ii) One Sewage Pumping Station with capacity of minimum 10 MLD
- (b) Operating and maintaining of at least one Sewerage Network (including Pumping station) of minimum 60 Km length and one sewage Pumping station of capacity minimum 10 MLD for a period of 1year during last 7 years (i.e. Year 2009-10 to Year 2015-16)

(c) Experience of design, build and commissioning sewer line of minimum 1.5 Km of length using any trenchless technology as approved by Ind STT during last 7 years (i.e. Year 2009-10 to Year 2015-16)

(d) Experience of rehabilitation of minimum 5.0 Km length of sewer line using any lining technology as approved by Ind STT during last 7 years and de-silting experience of at least 70 Km of sewer line during last 7 years. (i.e., Year 2009-10 to Year 2015-16).

For the purpose of demonstrating the design experience requirement specified in Section 1.4 (a) (1) and the experience specified in Section 1.4 (a) (2) to Section 1.2 (a) (4), the Bidder, whether a single entity or a joint venture Bidder may claim the experience of its nominated sub-contractors and sub-consultants. The Bidder shall submit with its bid, details of the qualification and experience of the nominated sub-contractors and sub-consultants in the prescribed Information Forms in accordance with Section 1.2 (b).

6. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding Procedure as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: - Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants, January 2011 revised July, 2014, and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 of the Guidelines setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
7. The General Manager, Ganga Pollution Control Unit, U. P. Jal Nigam, Kanpur for and on behalf of the Owner in the State of Uttar Pradesh, India invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the works detailed in the table below.

The bidders who download the documents from the website and use the same for submission of the bids should note that if there is any discrepancy between the downloaded document and the hard copy of the document issued to the bidders, the hard copy shall be treated as final and shall prevail over the downloaded documents.
11. The bidders who download the documents shall have to pay along with their bid submission, the non-refundable cost of Rs. 21000 including VAT or US \$325 in the form of a Certified Cheque/Demand Draft issued by a nationalized bank / foreign bank listed with the Reserve Bank of India having its branches in India, payable to the Project Manager, Construction Unit-II, U.P. Jal Nigam, Munshipurwa IPS (Naya pul) , Kanpur-208002 payable at Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh.
12. Bidders can also purchase the bid documents commencing from 22.12.2016 on payment of INR 21000 including VAT or US \$325 in the form of a Demand Draft issued by a nationalized bank / foreign bank listed with the Reserve Bank of India having its branches in India, payable to the Project Manager, Construction Unit-2. Bid documents requested by post shall be sent through speed post / registered post on payment of an extra amount of INR 1000/- or US\$ 16 . The Ganga Pollution Control Unit, U.P.
