गंगा बेसिन के साथ-साथ 5 किलोमीटर चौड़े कॉरीडोर स्थित जिलों में किसानों के लिए प्राकृतिक खेती पर प्रशिक्षण, कार्यशालाएं, क्षमता निर्माण कार्यक्रम आयोजित करने के लिए निजी एजेंसियों/संस्थानों/संगठनों/व्यवसायियों/एफपीओ की पहचान/सूचीकरण/चयन

भारत सरकार ने यह स्वीकार करते हुए कि गंगा नदी के दीर्घकालिक संरक्षण से इसके बेसिन में रहने वाले 50 करोड़ लोगों के जीवन में महत्वपूर्ण सामाजिक और आर्थिक लाभ होगा, गंगा नदी की स्वच्छता को अपनी प्राथमिकताओं में से एक के रूप में पहचान की है। इस प्रयोजन हेतु मई 2015 में, भारत सरकार ने गंगा नदी की स्वच्छता, संरक्षण और सुरक्षा हेतु प्रमुख नमामि गंगे कार्यक्रम को स्वीकृति प्रदान की। वर्ष 2014-15 में आरंभ की गई नमामि गंगे मिशन, गंगा नदी बेसिन के संरक्षण, सुरक्षा और कायाकल्प के लिए एक केन्द्रीय क्षेत्र की योजना है।

मई 2022 तक मिशन ने विभिन्न संघटकों, जैसे सीवरेज बुनियादी ढांचा, औद्योगिक प्रदूषण उपशमन, जैव विविधता, दलदली भूमि संरक्षण, भूमिगत जल प्रबंधन, वनीकरण, समर्थन और सार्वजनिक पहुंच, अनुसंधान और विकास के अन्तर्गत 31,324 करोड़ रुपए लागत की 373 परियोजनाओं को स्वीकृति प्रदान की थी। नमामि गंगे गंगा नदी में पर्यावरणीय प्रदूषण की रोकथाम, नियंत्रण और उपशमन तथा जल के लगातार पर्याप्त प्रवाह को सुनिश्चित करने के लिए उपायों को अपनाने पर केंद्रित है ताकि गंगा नदी का संरक्षण किया जा सके। गंगा बेसिन के पास खेतों में बाह्य रसायनिक इनपुट के भारी प्रयोग के कारण कीटनाशकों और जीव मारकों (पेस्टीसाइड्स) जैसे रसायनों की बढ़ती हुई मात्रा को बहाने के कारण गंगा नदी गंभीर खतरे का सामना कर रही है।

नमामि गंगे का उद्देश्य गंगा नदी के पास कृषि अभ्यासों को प्राकृतिक बनाना, किसानों की आय में सुधार करना और नदी से जुड़ी पारिस्थितिकी, मृदा, जल और जैव विविधता का भी संरक्षण करना है। वर्ष 2022-23 के बजट में गंगा नदी के दोनों ओर के 5 कि.मी. के विस्तार में प्राकृतिक खेती को बढ़ावा दिए जाने को अनिवार्य किया गया है। इस आमंत्रण का मुख्य उद्देश्य इस अनिवार्यता का क्रियान्वयन करना है।

एन.एम.सी.जी पात्र निजी एजेंसियों/संस्थानों/संगठनों/व्यवसायियों/एफपीओ आदि को गंगा बेसिन में किसानों के लिए प्राकृतिक खेती पर प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करने / कार्यशालाएं आयोजित करने / क्षमता निर्माण कार्यक्रमों में अपनी रुचि को दर्शाने के लिए आमंत्रित करता है। आवेदकों को अपने आवेदन को इस कार्य को निष्पादित करने से संबंधित अपनी अपेक्षित योग्यताओं और संगत अनुभव संबंधी सूचना से समर्थित करना चाहिए।

लघु सूचियन संबंधी मानदंड निम्नानुसार हैं:-

- एजेंसी के पास कार्यशालाओं / प्रशिक्षण सत्रों को आयोजित करने / प्राकृतिक खेती के अभ्यास या क्रियान्वयन और एफपीओ / किसानों के समूहों आदि के साथ काम करने का प्रासंगिक अनुभव होना चाहिए।
- एजेंसी द्वारा अधिमानतः किसानों के लिए कम से कम एक समान कार्य (कार्यशालाएं आयोजित करना / स्थल प्रशिक्षण / अभिज्ञता दौरों या विस्तृत पहचान और प्रभाव के लिए कोई अन्य विषय वस्तु / परियोजना) किया गया होना चाहिए।

आवेदक को उपलब्ध कराए गए अनुबंध के अनुसार सभी दस्तावेज प्रस्तुत करने चाहिए। आवेदन के सभी पृष्ठ और प्रस्तुत किए जा रहे समर्थक दस्तावेज आवेदक / फर्म द्वारा, दस्तावेजों की विषय-वस्तु के स्वरूप के निरपेक्ष, हस्ताक्षरित और क्रमिक रूप से संख्यांकित होने चाहिए। बिना हस्ताक्षर और बिना स्टाम्प के आवेदन को स्वीकार नहीं किया जाएगा।

The GoI, recognizing that long-term rejuvenation of the river Ganga will have significant social and economic benefits on the lives of the 500 million people living along its basin, has identified cleaning of the river Ganga as one of its priorities. For this purpose, in May 2015, the GoI approved the flagship Namami Gange programme for cleaning, rejuvenation, and protection of the river Ganga.

Launched in 2014-15, Namami Gange is a central sector scheme for the conservation, protection and rejuvenation of the Ganga River Basin

As of May 2022, the Mission had sanctioned 373 projects worth Rs 31,324 crore under various components such as sewerage infrastructure, industrial pollution abatement, biodiversity, wetland conservation, groundwater management, afforestation, advocacy and public outreach, research and development, amongst others. Namami Gange is focused on taking measures for prevention, control and abatement of environmental pollution in river Ganga and to ensure continuous adequate flow of water so as to rejuvenate the river Ganga. River Ganga has been facing serious threats due to discharge of increasing quantities of chemicals such as insecticides and pesticides on account of heavy use of external chemical inputs in farms near the Ganga basin.

Namami Gange aims to make agriculture practices natural along the Ganga River, improve the farmers' income and also conserve river linked ecology, soil, water and biodiversity. The Budget, 2022-23 has mandated promoting Natural Farming in 5 km stretch on either side of river Ganga. The main objective of this invitation is to implement this mandate.

NMCG invites eligible **Private Agencies/ Institutes/ Organizations/ Practitioners/ FPO etc.** to indicate their interest in imparting training, conducting

workshops / capacity building programmes on Natural Farming for farmers in Ganga Basin. The Applicants should support their applications with information about their required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the task.

The Shortlisting Criteria are as follows:

- The agency should have relevant experience in conducting workshops/training sessions/practising or implementing Natural Farming and working with FPOs/ Farmers' Groups etc.;
- The agency should have preferably carried out at least one similar work (organizing workshops /field training/exposure visits or any theme/project for wider recognition and effect) for farmers.

The Applicant must submit all documents as per Annexure provided. All pages of the application & supporting documents being submitted must be signed and sequentially numbered by the Applicant / firm irrespective of the nature of content of the documents. Unsigned and unstamped Application will not be accepted.

Scope of Work for promotion of Natural Farming for Ganga River Basin

“Namami Gange Programme” is the flagship programme of National Mission for Clean Ganga focused on taking measures for prevention, control and abatement of environmental pollution in river Ganga and to ensure continuous adequate flow of water so as to rejuvenate the river Ganga. Under Namami Gange Programme, NMCG is implementing the government initiative of promoting natural farming in 5 km stretch on either side of river Ganga.

River Ganga has been facing serious threats due to discharge of increasing quantities of chemicals such as insecticides and pesticides on account of heavy use of external chemical inputs in farms near the Ganga basin. Namami Gange aims to make agriculture practices natural along the Ganga River, improve the farmers’ income and also conserve river linked ecology, soil, water and biodiversity.

Background:

Since the era of Green Revolution, chemical inputs have become an integral part of agriculture. These chemical inputs - in the form of fertilizers and pesticides - resulted in high crop yields thus, decreasing food deficiency. But heavy and inefficient use of chemical inputs gradually showed an adverse impact on nature. Inefficient use of inputs started dominating the farm due to lack of right knowledge and training to the farmers. Use of chemical inputs also poses serious health hazards for farmers. Farmers use bare hands to prepare these chemical dilutions and formulations hence, being exposed to many diseases, respiratory problems and other related toxicity.

NMCG is exploring possibility to accelerate the adoption of farming based on the concept of circular economy (from the farm for the farm concept) across India by promoting Natural Farming with use of Jeevamrit and other farm made inputs which prevent chemicals from entering into the value chain and eventually rivers. NMCG aims to make agriculture practices natural and organic along the Ganga River, improve farmers’ income, and also conserve river-linked ecology, soil, water, and biodiversity. NMCG has taken several initiatives in this regard in coordination with the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare for encouraging farmers to adopt sustainable natural agricultural practices. NMCG sanctioned a study project on “Evaluation of Natural Farming practices on water and energy savings, and Enhancement of Soil Fertility & Crop Productivity” – WALAMTARI, Andhra Pradesh for 3 years.

Now the focus of NMCG is on 'Arth Ganga', which aims to connect people with the river/nature and establish an economic linkage between them for sustenance and through this exercise, encourage usage of farm made agri-inputs and develop a model to reduce dependency of farmers on expensive external agri-inputs.

Through this partnership, NMCG wishes to explore the possibility of developing a monitored and managed system, for right transfer of knowledge and handholding to the farmers assuring increased and smooth adoption of Natural Farming in 5 km stretch on either side of river Ganga in the five states: Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and West Bengal.

Scope of Work

- To motivate farmers and accelerate the adoption of Natural Farming along the Ganga Basin via training, workshop and exposure visits to successful Natural Farming Farms.
- To support NMCG in ensuring a smooth transition from chemical-based / organic farming system to Natural Farming by providing on field handholding, develop uniform Package of Practice (PoP) for Natural Farming and identify the need of subsidy and support required by the farmers.

The roles and responsibilities of the agencies may include but not be limited to the following:

1. Agencies/Practitioner shall conduct training and capacity buildings of FPOs/Farmers group - Training needs identification, develop training modules, conduct basic training workshops and exposure visits.
2. Agencies/Practitioner shall conduct periodic farmer survey regarding requirements and challenges in adoption of Natural Farming by the Farmers.
3. Conduct field demonstration and organize village level farmers' meeting for knowledge exchange and experience sharing.
4. Conduct follow-up farm visits for mobilization of farmers, encourage and promote Natural Farming amongst Farmers/ FPOs.

5. Assist NMCG in cluster finalization and farmers mobilization – cluster finalization, value chain identification, formation of Natural Farming Cluster Area with the Farmers.
6. Providing incubation / handholding services for sustainability of Natural Farming system which includes capacity building of Farmers for sustainability, ensuring right knowledge transfer on preparation of natural farm inputs, necessary common pool production amongst farmers, market linkages, to develop the cluster for long-term viability.
7. Agencies/ Practitioner to display company logo (along with NMCG and Arth Ganga) / branding at the events being conducted for promotion of Natural Farming.
